1) Arctic Frontiers and YSF 2021

RG attended the Arctic Frontiers Science Steering Committee meeting and gave a short update. Arctic Frontiers will take place February 1-4, 2021 with two days of science first, followed by two days of politics and business. There will be six sessions, ranging over a wide selection of topics and disciplines with session 5 being the most relevant for ARCTOS: 'The coupled Arctic system: Improved understand from recent international campaigns'. The session is primarily targeted at recent findings from MOSAiC, Changing Arctic Ocean, and the Nansen legacy.

YSF is unlikely to happen in 2021 due to the lack of a course responsible who needs to be an associate professor/professor at UiT. If ARCTOS were to change to a biannual plan, this would have to be approved by the ARCTOS Board at the meeting planned for September 2020. For 2022, we would need two people to feel responsible for YSF and a new course responsible. EL is interested in contributing to the workshop again. RG will apply to UiT for getting the teaching hours covered and JB will ask Paul Wassmann if all teaching hours were covered in previous years.

For AF 2022, KC and HH made suggestions for sessions, RG forwarded them, and they will be discussed at a meeting May 27.

2) ARCTOS annual report 2019

UG will prepare a merged document of the two currently existing documents, the outline and the draft she has started and send it out to the Secretariat asap. All secretariat members should send their contributions indicated in the new document until latest June 8 to UG, who will prepare the final version.

3) Do we want an ARCTOS lead science session at ASSW 2021?

Correction: open call for side meetings at ASSW 2021. The deadline to propose sessions has passed. There is also student support available. The secretariat has no suggestions and UG will announce this for the whole network in the next newsletter.

ASSW 2022 will take place in Tromsø (26/3-1/4) and ARCTOS should try to be a strong partner and aim for an ARCTOS led session.
