Under AOB, the post-doc representatives wanted to give a short update about past and planned activities

1) ARCTOS proposal to NFR

After the NFR budget crisis some calls were closed, such as the one ARCTOS wanted to apply to, but now this call has been re-opened. Eva contacted NFR and received a confirmation.

To our knowledge nobody has applied to this call yet and based on the feedback Eva received, we can expect to get support for the existing network and do not need to come up with an entirely new concept.

As the starting point a working group was established which will work with the proposal, consisting of Rolf, Paul, Eva, Terri, Igor, Christine/Muriel, Libby, and Ulrike. The input and active contribution by young researchers is of very high importance.

All Secretariat members should send their suggestions for actions to be included in the proposal to this working group by latest Monday June 20th, 8:00 am CET. Member institution representatives should try to include their institutions perspectives.

Post-doc and PhD student update

The post-doc representatives are pushing forward to get the mentorship program established. As it is difficult to establish mentorship relationships between post-docs and PhDs, they decided to organize a workshop focusing on academic CVs and job opportunities, combined with a social get-together afterwards on June 3rd. The workshop and social get-together were well attended, and more workshops are planned for autumn.

From August the post-doc representatives will organize monthly meetings with 2-3 invited ARCTOS senior members to talk about challenges in their career development. For the first meeting, Sophie, Mikko, and Markus will attend.

We touched quickly upon the lack of activities within ARCTOS during the last months and that this has implications for the visibility and attractiveness of the network. Also new promotional material is needed but partly depends on funding available.

One last point was how post-docs could get 'credits' for their mentoring and organizing activities and the Secretariat decided that the post-docs should keep a log and can then ask the ARCTOS leadership for a letter of confirmation when needed.
